


Joshua and Gardner, the artistic core of EBN, met while students ode Island School of Design. In 1987, the two artists founded an on known as Pearson Post Industries (PPI), a multi-media art n a special interest in propaganda, politics and corporate

As PPI, Joshua and Gardner exhibited multi-media installations, interactive video displays and large mechanical sculptures, in rt galleries. PPI also created such unusual works as "model t" (a Providence apartment transformed into a "miniature Disney-use"), the "golf bag missile launch system" (a pseudo "personal system") and the "telepodium" (a mock presidential podium with IV monitors attached to either side). The telepodium has always been a mainstay of our show. It the idea of television as a weapon and also represents the politics and television.
